Integrative Studies Requirements

40 credits minimum

Students select an academic minor, other than the Early Childhood minor, to complement their Early Childhood Development Option. Students will gain a multidisciplinary understanding of early childhood development. The program integrates theory and practice with young children (infants, toddlers, and preschoolers) and their families in inclusive settings and provides pre-professional inclusive field experiences. Students will gain knowledge and experience with diverse learners, child development, family involvement, curriculum and assessment, and leadership. Successful completion of this option will prepare students for the New Hampshire Early Childhood Credential.
